## **Covid-19 Protocols**

The health and well-being of our athletes, coaches & families remain our top priority. In order to minimize the risk of COVID-19 entering our environment and spreading amongst our community, Jeff Voris Football Camps' staff has put in place numerous preventative measures and protocols. However, they cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending Jeff Voris Football Camps could increase your risk and your child(ren)'s risk of contracting COVID-19.

Furthermore, all participants in sponsored activities by Jeff Voris Football Camps must agree to and abide by the following:

- If a camper or coach is sick, they should not come to camp.
- Anyone showing symptoms or registering a temperature greater than 100.4 will not be permitted to participate and will be sent home.
- Campers will have their temperature taken upon arrival at camp. If they register a
  temperature greater than 100.4 degrees, they will not be permitted to enter and will be
  sent home.
- Athletes should bring their own water bottle.
- Hand sanitizer will be available; however, it is strongly suggested that campers bring their own.
- Social distancing is required except during camp drills, competitions, and games.
- Campers and coaches must wear masks during all camp activities. Masks may be removed only when eating or drinking at a social distance.
- Masks will not be provided by Jeff Voris Football Camps.
- Campers must follow all procedures set forth by Butler University and its Athletic Department while in Hinkle Fieldhouse or the Sellick Bowl.
